Minha/ Tashlikh . . .meet 1 hr. earlier for special readings	5:00 pm.
'Arbith (No Layla Wadday)	7:00 pm
Light candles with Sheheheyanu (not before)	7:32 pm

Note: Candles may not be lit before 7:32 pm., unless Qiddush is being made before that time, in which case they should be lit just prior to the making of Qiddush.

Friday, Sept. 30 (2nd of Tashri) 2nd day of Rosh Hashanah

Shahrith (includes Shofar)	8:30 am.
Light candles (30 mins.)	6:07 pm.
Minha/'Arbith . . . meet earlier for special readings	6:10 pm.
